While participating in my class, please adhere to these three principles:

## Be Fearless.

Trying new things can be scary, but I believe every dancer has the ability to reach their full potential.

- Do's Give 100% in every class. Being the hardest working dancer is more important than being the most talented.
  - Come prepared. Dress properly, bring a notebook and writing utensil, and remember any choreography we have previously learned.
  - Dance and perform in class like you are on stage.
  - Have FUN! Dance is a serious art form, but is also a great time to let go and enjoy yourself.
- Attire Each discipline of dance has its own traditions, etiquette and dress code. You can't wear a leotard and spandex shorts to Hip Hop, just like you wouldn't wear a tank top and joggers to Ballet. I teach a variety of genres each day and expect my students to treat each genre with respect and dress accordingly.
  - Hair should be pulled back for all classes.
  - Leotard, tights, and proper shoes are required for all ballet and jazz classes.

Be EDGY.

Be unique. Be Honest. Be you!

- Say "I can't". I can't help you be your best if you aren't willing to TRY your best!
- Be afraid! Don't be afraid to ask questions, make new friends, and go outside your comfort zone!
- Ignore any corrections. Take all corrections given in class and apply them to your own dancing.
- Lose focus. We have so much to do in a short time, so keep talking to a minimum and leave your hair and clothes alone.
